

## POWER ON/OFF, ANC SWITCH



Power On: Long press the power button 3s, the blue LED light will be steady on 2s and then go off after flash slowly once.

Power Off: Long press the power button for about 4s, the red LED light will up 2s and

ANC On: Short press the ANC button once, to switch for different ANC levels, with prompt sound "ANC 1" and "ANC 2", and "Ambient Sound". The ANC blue indicator

ANC Off: Short press the ANC button once, and the ANC blue indicator lights goes

Note: In order to avoid the failure of the power switch to the greatest extent, it is recommended to wait for 2-3 seconds to restart again after turn off the headphone.






- 1. Long press the power button 3s in the power-off state to hear power on. After 5s, hear paring enter the pairing mode, and the indicator light flashes alternately in red and blue.

  2. After the first connection, the headset will automatically connect back to the last
- connected device when it is turned on;


  3. If you want to change the device or enter forced pairing, long press the power
